## Free participation in the Norwegian Language and Civic Life for Adult Immigrants Programme

## The right to participate free of charge in the Norwegian Language and Civic Life Programme for Adult Immigrants Programme

Your residence permit in Norway can give you the right to a total of 600 hours of free training in:

- Norwegian language (550 hours), and
- Civic Life (50 hours)

The programme is free of charge for a period of three years:

- From the date you were granted a residence permit, or
- From the date of your arrival in Norway with a valid residence permit

You will be required to pay to participate in the programme if you have not started or completed the programme by the end of these three years.

## Compulsory participation in the Norwegian language and Civic Life for Adult Immigrants Programme

You can be obliged to complete 600 hours of compulsory participation in Norwegian Language and Civic Life Programme in order to have an application granted for:

- A permanent residence permit, and/or
- Norwegian citizenship

You can apply for exemption from the compulsory programme if:

- You can document sufficient knowledge of Norwegian language or Sami language, or
- You can show that you are unable to follow the programme for health reasons or for other weighty reasons.

## **Practical information**

In order to apply for the programme, or if you wish to apply for exemption, you must contact the Adult Education Service ("Voksenopplæringen") in the municipality where you are registered in the Population Register.
