Everyone who is participating in an Introduction Programme in Norway is invited to participate in a national user survey.

We hope that you will take this opportunity to respond to a few questions regarding how you have experienced participating in the Introduction Programme. The survey contains fixed response options that you can choose from.

The survey is conducted by the Norwegian Directorate of Integration and Diversity (IMDi).

In order for us and your municipality to be able to provide you and other Introduction Programme participants with even better services, we want to receive your experiences as a participant.

It is important that you are open and honest in your responses, so that we receive accurate information about what can be improved. For example, you will be asked whether you are satisfied with the training you are participating in, whether you enjoy participating in the programme and whether there is anything you think is negative in the programme.

Participation is voluntary and it will take approximately 30 minutes to respond to the user survey. The user survey is anonymous. Your answers cannot be traced back to you as an individual. All information will be processed confidentially by the project staff members at IMDi and a few selected researchers who are the only persons with access to the responses. No one in the municipality or others will have access to view what you have answered.

Your municipality will give you access to participate in the user survey.

You can select the language of the survey. Use the language icons at the bottom of the page. All questions and response options are available as both text and audio. Use the audio icon if you would like to listen to the questions and response options.

You have to complete the entire questionnaire in one session.
